Support Beyond Tuition

Annual Fund Drive

Who coordinates: Helene Clancy (Parent Volunteer Chair), Development Office

When: Fall solicitation through letters and a phonathon.

Participation: Current families, alumni, grandparents, alum parents, faculty/staff, friends and corporations through matching gifts.

Benefits: The Annual Fund proceeds support the school's operations budget (approximately 5%).

The 2008 - 2009 goal is \$260,000.

Auction

Who coordinates: Erin Saparto & Dawn Hines (Parent Volunteer Co-Chairs), Development Office

When: Summer/Fall procurement. Gala Auction will be held on February 7, 2009 at the Lynnwood Convention Center.

Participation: AMHS Families are to donate or procure items with a value of \$300 and encouraged to attend the event. Current parents and friends attend the event.

Benefits: The Auction proceeds support the AMHS operations budget (approximately 5%). The 2008 - 2009 net goal is \$260,000.

The campaign will also allocate funds to pay the remaining construction costs for Heath Hall.

The campaign goal is \$2.0 million.
