

AMHS Food Drive 2008

This year, the AMHS holiday food drive is being organized by the Campus Ministry office, with the assistance of the ASB and Junior Class Officers. The ASB and Junior Class Officers have distributed lists to each of the homeroom teachers, as well as a list to the main office for all staff and the remaining teachers. Each list contains items to be raised over the course of the food drive, which will run from November 5 to November 25. Along with food and non-perishable items, we are asking for each class to raise a monetary donation based on the minimum amount of \$5 per student.

Based on class size, each homeroom has an established goal of items and money. Each Friday, officers will visit their assigned homerooms to calculate their tally based on the percentage of items/money per student. The homeroom(s) that has/have the highest percentage for each week will win a Super Dress Pass, which will allow homeroom students to enjoy ONE DAY of free dress, including hats, flip flops, and sweats. The tally will start over each Monday.

We will calculate these homeroom winners on November 7, 14, and 21 and announce them by the end of that day. The homeroom with the highest percentage of items by November 24 will win a special lunch courtesy of the ASB. The second place homeroom will win breakfast served by the ASB.

Teachers are encouraged to offer motivation of their own for their respective classes. Friendly wagers and healthy competition is encouraged.

The end result is to collect as much food, non-perishable items, and monetary donations as we can to help the Everett St. Vincent de Paul in this time of need. The holiday season can be extremely stressful for families who are under financial pressure – with our help, we can hopefully offer our prayers and support to those in our community.

Parents – if you would like to make your \$5 student contribution through our SCRIP program, it has been set up to do so. On the SCRIP order page, simply click the appropriate box. Please send a copy of your SCRIP order with your student, so it can be turned in to their teacher as a record of the donation. Contributions beyond \$5 are also acceptable and will count towards the homeroom total.
