

Class Officer Application Information
Offices for 2008-2009

Thank you for thinking about running for a Class Officer position for the 2008-09 school year. Here is some information about the process as well as the requirements for running a campaign and the structure of the Student Government at Archbishop Thomas J. Murphy High School.

The following positions are available for ASB office, which is limited to current juniors who will be seniors in the following school year. In addition to these positions, the Director of Student Life may appoint up to two students to join the ASB:

Election Process:

1. Students are to complete the application form and type a one page essay explaining why they want to run and what they hope to accomplish as a class officer.
2. Students are to attend a mandatory candidate meeting during lunch with Mr. Schmutz—time TBD.
3. Students may campaign from 8:00am on Monday, through the elections on Friday.
4. Students will give a two to three minute campaign speech at the class meeting on Friday. This speech must be approved by Mr. Schmutz before Friday.
5. All campaign materials (posters, fliers, buttons, etc.) must be approved by Class Moderators.
6. Students may not use candy, gum, or any other food as part of the campaign.
7. Students may not use stickers of any type as part of campaign materials.
8. Expenses for the campaign may not exceed \$20.00 in actual or donated costs. Please submit a copy of all expenses to Mr. Schmutz by election day.
9. All campaign material must be properly disposed of by 3:00pm on election day.
10. Balloting will take place following the speeches for registered voters.
11. Votes will be tallied by the current Executive Council members (ASB). The winners will be announced no later than the following day at school.
